The Centre & Charity

Opened in 2004 by the Princess Royal, Princess Anne, the facility was transferred to a charity, the Coddendam Centre Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) and renamed in November 2019. Since 2020 it has become a successful, environmentally friendly, award winning venue.

The Centre includes a professional kitchen, reception foyer, meeting room, a full inventory of catering equipment, linen and communal changing rooms with toilet facilities, including disabled access and baby changing. Outside facilities provide a play area, exercise or spectator sports, gym equipment, tennis, pickleball and basketball, all catered for in safe and pleasant surroundings.

Hall

A large hall with high ceilings suitable for multi purpose usage. It has a sprung wooden floor and ample natural daylight. It is 9m wide x 17m long, with a seating capacity of 130-150. The premises are fully licensed and can accommodate up to 200 people for dining, conferences or entertainment. Drapes and staging can be provided. It also offers badminton, indoor tennis, pickleball and bowls, with options for other sports and exercise, indoors and out.

Meeting Room

A private training or meeting room is available to accommodate up to 15 people. Free high-speed wifi is available throughout.

Outside Facilities

Picnic, play, exercise or spectator sports are all catered for. Through donations, grants and community fund raising, the Centre has safe play equipment for children, including a popular zip wire. For adults there is outside gymnasium equipment, alongside a full sized football and playing field. Tennis, basketball courts and a fully equipped bowling green, are also available.

Environment

Our award winning Centre is kind to the planet, powered by air source heat pumps and solar energy with optimum insulation, LED lighting and a range of initiatives which have given us Suffolk's Gold Carbon Charter accreditation.
